La hora (Time)

When giving the time for one o'clock in Spanish, you use the phrase "Es la" for "It is."
Es la una. It is one.

When giving the time for two o'clock through 12 o'clock in Spanish, you use the phrase "Son las" for "It is."
Son las dos. It is two.

Important terms to remember:

"Quarter Past" = Cuarto

"Half Past" = Media

"Minus" = Menos

In Spanish, after the half hour mark, you can choose to tell time by subtracting from the next hour or by using the current hour.

Ejemplo:

"2:35" = Son las tres menos veinticinco.

"2:35" = Son las dos y treinta y cinco.
